Construction work on most major highway projects throughout the state will be suspended during the three-day Memorial Day weekend to help travelers reach their destination safely and efficiently. Construction in highway work zones, including most operations related to the I-39/90 Project, will stop by noon today (May 26) and will not resume until 6 a.m. Tuesday (May 30).

All lanes and interchange ramps along I-39/90, between Beloit and Madison, are OPEN except for the northbound Interstate ramps to/from the US 51 interchange (Stoughton Exit 156).

As you make your travel plans, visit <u>Wisconsin's 511 travel information website</u>, <u>download the 511 WI mobile app</u> or call 511 for travel times, incidents and more. Please keep your heads up and phones down when driving!

<u>Weekly Construction Update: May 30 - June 2</u>All lane restrictions and work operations are weather dependent and subject to change.

Two lanes remain open to traffic on I-39/90 (in each direction) during daytime hours.

NOTE: Next week Tuesday through Friday (8 p.m. to 5 a.m.) and Friday to Saturday (10 p.m. to 7 a.m.), nightly single lane closures are planned on I-39/90 northbound and southbound in the following work zones, unless noted otherwise. Minor delays may occur during these lane closures.

NOTE: Holiday work restrictions in effect from noon today (May 26) until 6 a.m. Tuesday (May 30).

County AB bridge replacement over I-39/90, south of Madison

- Updated: View County AB bridge operations.
 - Some noise from activities is expected throughout the week.
- County AB over I-39/90 CLOSED to all traffic until early September 2017.
 - Alternate routes are required. Signed detour route: US 12/18, County N and County MN.

I-39/90 and County N interchange (Exit 147), north of Stoughton

- Updated: View County N interchange operations.
 - Mid next week, County N traffic between Koshkonong Road and I-39/90 will be shifted onto temporary widening. Be alert for these lane shifts!
- County N is CLOSED to all traffic, between the I-39/90 northbound ramps and Rinden Road, near the township of Pleasant Springs.
 - Alternate local routes are required. Signed detour route: I-39/90, US 12/18 and County N.
 - This section of highway is anticipated to reopen in fall 2017.
- Updated: The County N and Rinden Road intersection is scheduled to be CLOSED starting Thursday (June 1). Alternate local routes are required.
 - Intersection to re-open by August 1, 2017.
 - Access maintained to all properties within this closure.

I-39/90 (Dane/Rock County line to E. Church Road) and US 51 interchange, east of Stoughton

- Updated: View construction operations.
- All I-39/90 traffic shifted onto southbound side of Interstate, between the Dane/Rock County line to East Church Road, north of the US 51 interchange (Stoughton Exit 156).
 - Two lanes remain open in each direction, separated by a median barrier wall. Be alert for crossovers in this area, and please stay in your lane!
 - o Northbound ramps CLOSED at the US 51 interchange (Stoughton Exit 156).
 - The southbound Interstate on and off ramps at Stoughton Exit 156 will remain open during construction with periodic nighttime ramp closures.
- Local roads under I-39/90 to be CLOSED until early June. View construction activities.
 - Lake Drive Road under Interstate 39/90 near Edgerton, and East Church Road under I-39/90, near the town of Christiana.
 - Emergency access to be provided to police, fire and EMS.

I-39/90 and WIS 59 interchange and Rock River bridges, near Edgerton and Newville

- I-39/90 northbound traffic shifted onto the new concrete lanes and bridge over the Rock River.
 - Be alert for lane shifts and slow down reduced speed limit of 60 mph.
- Northbound Interstate traffic crossover to southbound side at Dane/Rock County line, north of the WIS 59 interchange.
 - Be alert and please stay in your lane!
- Updated: View Interstate and Rock River bridge operations.
 - Download the Rock River Bridge, Boater Navigation Guide!
 - Navigational buoys to be placed in river under I-39/90. Boaters should slow down (this
 area is no wake), and be alert for construction crews and work taking place.
- Ellendale Road under I-39/90 along the Rock River remains OPEN to all traffic.
 - Flagging operations will occur periodically on Ellendale Road as crews unload trucks and reach material stored along the road.
- Updated: View WIS 59 interchange activities. Be alert for crews and equipment in the interchange area.
- Access remains open to area businesses and neighborhoods. Please continue to patronize the businesses in the project area!

Manague Road bridge replacement over I-39/90, north of Janesville

- Updated: View Manague Road bridge operations.
 - Some noise from activities is expected throughout the week.
- Manogue Road over I-39/90 CLOSED to all traffic until late August 2017.
 - Alternate local routes are required.

Temporary widening of I-39/90 southbound, near Beloit

Between the County S (Shopiere Road) interchange and the Illinois state line

- Updated: View temporary widening activities, near Beloit.
- Traffic shifted on I-39/90 southbound near I-43/WIS 81 interchange. Please be alert and stay in your lane!

Hart Road bridge girder repairs, near Beloit

- Updated: View Hart Road bridge repair activities.
- Hart Road to remain open to local traffic. Be alert for crews and equipment in the area.
 - Updated: Hart Road anticipated to be CLOSED from Friday, June 9 to Monday, June
 12 for deck pour/cure weather dependent.

Stateline Road bridge replacement over I-39/90, near Beloit

- Updated: View Stateline Road bridge operations.
 - o Traffic shifts in place at the Wisconsin state line. Be alert for lane changes in this area!
- Stateline Road over I-39/90 CLOSED to all traffic until mid-August 2017. Alternate local routes are required.
